An Event to Go Down in History...



An important event demands a spectacular setting and few places can rival the old world elegance of the National Museum of Ireland – Decorative Arts & History at Collins Barracks.

Steeped in history, the Museum has four elegant spaces ideally suited to holding corporate events such as conferences, receptions, seminars, meetings, banquets and launches.

Dating back to 1704, Collins Barracks has housed various army troops over three centuries. The site remained a barracks for British troops until 1922 when it was taken over by the Irish Army and re-named Collins Barracks after the first commander-in-chief of the Irish Free State. Today, it is home to the Headquarters of The National Museum of Ireland and showcases fascinating exhibits on military history, clothing, furniture, silver, ceramics, coins and glassware.


For ease of access, the Museum has free car parking, a dedicated 'Museum' stop on the Luas line and is conveniently located beside Heuston Train Station, close to the city centre. All corporate spaces are fully wheelchair accessible.

Audio Visual Theatre




The Palatine Room's grand staircase, excellently equipped kitchen facilities and stunning views onto Clarke Square provide the perfect setting for memorable functions – both practically and aesthetically. Named after the German Palatine people, who were accommodated in the Barracks upon their arrival in 1706, the Palatine Room can be dressed to suit any occasion and caters for up to 100 people seated or 200 standing. The Palatine Room is available for hire during the day and evening.

Recently refurbished and with seating for 60-80 people, it features a private entrance, a dedicated reception and cloakroom facilities. 




Ante Room



With its magnificent views out onto Clarke Square, the entrance hall to the Museum is an attractive, generously proportioned and well-appointed space. Ideal for holding lunches, recitals and receptions, the Foyer can accommodate 200 people standing, and is available for hire from 17:00-21:00 daily.

The Ante Room is an intimate L-shaped room adjacent to Clarke Square and in close proximity to the Museum Café. The Museum can provide audio visual equipment, but the availability of specific equipment depends on the room in question.


Our rates are exempt of VAT and include the following:
