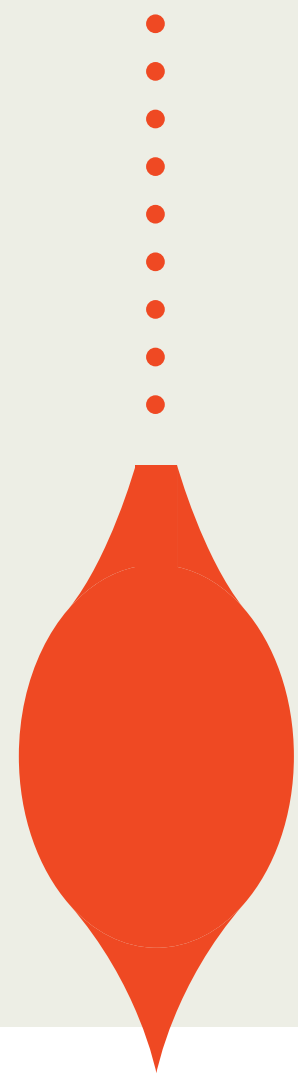

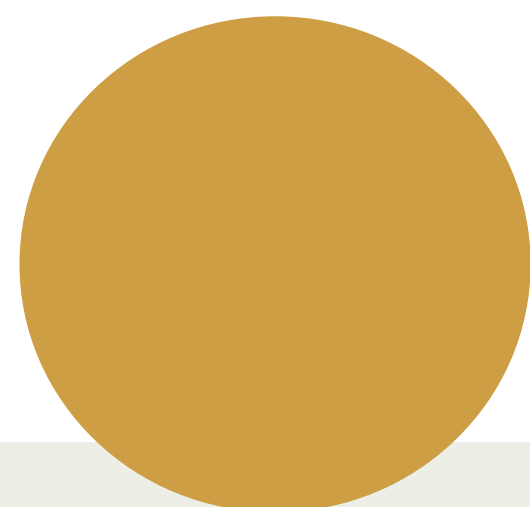
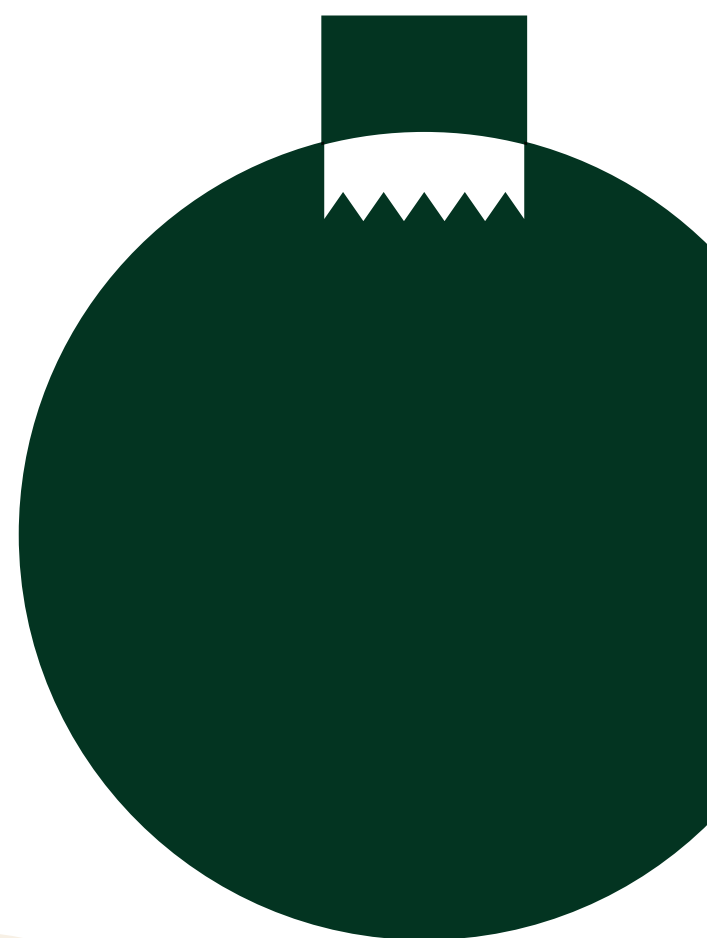


SAORSTAT EIREANN PENNY



When Ireland became independent from Britain about 100 years ago, there was a competition to design new coinage for Irish currency.
