1. Opening of meeting, apologies if any, and adoption of the agenda

The Board discussed the Masterplan process and the draft version of the Masterplan report with Mr Jardine and Mr Welsh.

It was agreed that the Board will send comments on the draft Masterplan to the Secretary (cc. Ms Scarff), who will compile the comments and send the feedback to Jura by Friday 24th March 2017.

It was agreed that Jura will to produce a summary report to accompany the broader Masterplan report.
