SAORSTÁT ÉIREANN PENNY






In 1926, four years after the establishment of the Irish Free State, a competition was held to design new coinage for Ireland. This coin was one of the winning designs by artist Percy Metcalfe and was released in 1928. Does anyone in your family remember coins like this penny?
