Tá fáilte romhat féachaint thart ar an taispeántas Ailtirí sna Scoileanna ag Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann – Saol na Tuaithe agus tá súil againn go mbainfidh tú taitneamh as. D'fhorbair daltaí Idirbhliana ó cheann ceann na hÉireann ábhar an taispeántais agus ba iad an Baile, an Inbhuanaitheacht agus an Pobal na téamaí a phléigh siad trí na bailiúcháin sa Mhúsaem a bhaineann le Saol na Tuaithe in Éirinn.

D'oibrigh na daoine óga i gcomhar le haití agus múinteoirí i gceardlanna chun na taispeántáin ar dhéanamh, líníochtaí 2T agus mionsamhlacha 3T ina measc, mar chuid den chlár náisiúnta Ailtirí sna Scoileanna ag Foras Ailtireachta na hÉireann. In 2021/22 ghlac 70 scoil, níos mó ná riamh, páirt sa chlár seo atá á reáchtáil ó 2013, agus chuir 45 díobh ábhar isteach le haghaidh an taispeántais. Is é an ceiliúradh seo ar chruthaitheacht daoine óga an taispeántais is mó ri amháin de chuid Ailtirí sna Scoileanna agus is comhoibriú straitéiseach é idir Ard-Mhúsaem na hÉireann agus Foras Ailtireachta na hÉireann.

FAIGH AMACH

Tá na taispeántáin ar taispeáint ina áiteanna éagsúla ar fud an Mhúsaem; mar sin, bí cinnte léarscál den taispeántas a fháil mar threoir agat ar do thuras. Coinnigh súil amach do réada i mbailiúchán Shaol na Tuaithe a bhfuil nasc idir iad agus téamaí an taispeántais. Stad agus déan do mhachnamh ar na smaointe úrnua fiseacha a mhol na daoine óga ar son timpeallacht thógrtha níos fearr. Éist leis na daoine óga agus iad ag plé théamaí an taispeántais agus ag nochtadh a gcuid smaointe faoin ailtireacht i scannán a coimisiúnaidh go speisialta agus atá le feiceáil san Amharclann chlosamhairc.



We invite you to explore and enjoy the Architects in Schools exhibition at the National Museum of Ireland – Country Life. The exhibition content was developed by Transition Year students from across Ireland in response to the themes of Home, Sustainability and Community, and the Museum's Irish Folklife collections.

Featuring 2D drawings and 3D models, the exhibits were made in workshops by young people, in collaboration with architects and teachers, as part of the Irish Architecture Foundation's national Architects in Schools programme. Running since 2013, this programme reached a record 70 schools in 2021/22, of which 45 schools submitted exhibition content. This celebration of young people's creativity is the largest Architects in Schools exhibition ever and marks a strategic collaboration between the National Museum of Ireland and the Irish Architecture Foundation.

DISCOVER

The exhibits are displayed in several locations throughout the Museum, so make sure to use this exhibition map to guide you on your journey. Watch out for objects in the Irish Folklife collection that link to exhibition themes. Pause and reflect on the original, visionary ideas proposed by young people, as they advocate for a better built environment. Hear directly from young people as they share their response to exhibition themes and reveal their ideas about architecture in a specially commissioned film, now on view in the Audio Visual Theatre.
