REPLICA BELL SHRINE



This is a replica or copy of the Shrine of St. Patrick's Bell, and was made in Dublin over 100 years ago. The original shrine is nearly 1000 years old and is inscribed with a prayer for its makers, Condulig Ua hInmainen and his sons, showing that in early times metalworkers often inherited their trade from their fathers. Can you think of anything that was passed down in your family? It could be a gift, a talent or even something like freckles!

Why not try replicating this bell as a Christmas decoration? You can make it sparkly with silver or gold paper or use ribbons or any materials that you like!
