#### **Arrival & orientation**

Arrive to the spectacular grounds of the National Museum of Ireland on a historic 30-acre estate at Turlough Park, Castlebar, Co Mayo. You will be welcomed at Museum Reception with an option to watch a short introductory film in our AV Theatre.

## Step back in time

Discover Ireland's National Folklife Collection, across four floors of award-winning exhibition galleries. Step back in time and marvel at the ingenuity, skill and endurance of our rural ancestors through customs, traditions, life in the home, textiles, clothing, and farming practices.

#### Victorian Gothic house

Visit the ancestral home of the Fitzgerald family to gain an insight into the lifestyle of landowners in Ireland in the 19th century. There are two restored formal rooms open to the public.

## **Biodiverse gardens**

Turlough Park is a Green Heritage Site and the award-winning gardens are some of the loveliest in the region. There are lots of interesting features to explore, including the glasshouse, the Richard Turner vinery, woodland walks and lakeside trails.
