MUNSTER FUSILIERS PRESENTATION DRUM



This drum was carried by a boy called Drummer Luttrell - we don't know his first name. He was a soldier in the British Army more than 100 years ago, when children could be soldiers. The drum has the crest of the 1st Royal Munster Fusiliers on it. His job was to beat a timing for the soldiers to march to.
