Valhallaween!

Viking Raven Masks – Instructions


What do you need?

- Print off of the Valhallaween Viking Raven Mask template
- Glue
- Scissors
- Card, such as colour card, or a cereal box
- Something to decorate. You can colour it, paint it, use glitter, feathers, sequins, beads, pipe cleaners, or whatever you find around the house!
- Hole puncher
- String

How do you make your mask?

- 1. Glue the template to a piece of card
- 2. Cut out the template of the mask and the nose piece by following the black outline
- 3. Cut out the two rectangular pieces
- Carefully cut out the eyes on the mask and use a hole puncher to cut out the nostrils on the nose. You might need an adult to help you with this
- 5. Fold the nose along the dotted lines and fold the rectangular pieces along the line. Use a hole puncher to make a hole in each of the rectangular pieces







- Glue the nose to the mask. The letters show 6. you where the nose piece should attach make sure that your coloured card is facing outwards and the template is stuck on the inside.
- 7. Glue the rectangular pieces to the back of the mask, on either side of the eyes
- String a piece of string threw the holes. 8. This is used to secure your mask
- Decorate your mask however you like! 9.

Top Tip! If you don't want to put a string on the back, you can glue a straw or a stick to the back and hold your mask up with your hand!
