




Help us find Peadar

Peadar is a Pygmy Shrew, Ireland's smallest mammal.



Pygmy Shrews are tiny. They are about 5cm long and only weigh 3 grams. They have especially long noses. A pygmy shrew has to eat at least its own body weight in food every day to stay alive. They like to eat lots of bugs - woodlice, beetles, flies and spiders.

They usually live outdoors in woodlands, hedgerows, farmland, gardens, and even bogs. They stay well hidden and are seldom seen.
