General schools booking information

We are delighted to welcome school groups to the National Museum of Ireland for self-guided visits and onsite guided tours and workshops.

All groups need to book their visit in advance through the Bookings Office.

Demand for visits is extremely high at present, so we would suggest contacting the Bookings Office with as much notice as possible, particularly if you wish to make a booking for a large group, or are looking to combine a visit to the National Museum of Ireland with visits to other locations to have the best chance of securing your preferred date and time of visit.

We would suggest contacting us at least two weeks in advance at present for a self-guided visit, and would recommend up to one month's notice for a facilitated visit, due to demand.
